

# FORM TO BE COMPLETED BY JUNIORS

## Bow High School Early Release/Late Arrival Privilege

**Early Release/Late Arrival will be available to juniors who earn the privilege through their academic attendance, disciplinary records and whose schedule will allow it.**

Juniors who have no scheduled classes during periods 1/2 or 7/8 (as appropriate) are eligible for Early Release/Late Arrival. To qualify, students must demonstrate the following:

- **Maintain passing grades in all subjects based on previous quarterly review.**
- **Demonstrate good citizenship and attendance.**
- **Sign-in with school ID whenever they exercise their privilege**

**Juniors failing a course will lose their privilege of early release/late arrival. Students may regain this privilege if their grades have improved *by progress reports*.**

Students who do not follow the rules of Early Release/Late Arrival will face consequences that could include loss of the privilege, detention, and/or suspension.

**Eligibility for this privilege will be determined on a quarterly basis. Students can earn or lose these privileges during the course of the school year.** In order to be eligible for Early Release/Late Arrival in the fall, a student must have met the requirements during the fourth quarter of the previous year. Students eligible for Early Release/Late Arrival must return a completed contract to the Main Office. This contract must be signed by both the student and his/her parent or guardian.

Students who secure a job and plan to use their Early Release/Late Arrival time for the job, should remember that the loss of the privilege will require them to stay at school and will jeopardize their employment.

If you feel that your son/daughter is ready to assume responsibility of using the Early Release/Late Arrival privilege, please indicate your approval. Remember that your approval of the Early Release/Late Arrival privilege for your son/daughter includes acceptance of the responsibility/liability for their actions while they are off campus. Students intending to participate must also sign this form indicating they understand the rules, regulations, qualifications, and consequences of the program and intend to accept them.

# FORM TO BE COMPLETED BY SENIORS

## Early Release/Late Arrival Privilege/Senior Open Campus

**Early Release/Late Arrival and Open Campus will be available to seniors who earn the privilege through their academic attendance, disciplinary records and whose schedule will allow it.**

Seniors who have no scheduled classes during periods 1/2 or 7/8 (as appropriate) are eligible for Early Release/Late Arrival. Seniors who have no scheduled classes for periods 3 to 6 are eligible for Senior Open Campus. To qualify for early release/late arrival or open campus seniors must demonstrate the following:

- **Maintain passing grades in all subjects based on previous quarterly review.**
- **Demonstrate good citizenship and attendance.**
- **Sign-in with school ID whenever they exercise their privilege**

Seniors failing a course will lose their privilege of open campus during periods 3 to 8. Students may regain this privilege if their grades have improved *by progress reports*.

Students on Early Release/Late Arrival should arrive/leave the school grounds within 10 minutes of the beginning of a class period. *Sixty minutes* must be remaining in a free block before eligible Senior students may leave and then return to their scheduled class. All Seniors must sign-in and out on a daily basis when using this privilege.

Students who do not follow the rules will face consequences that could include loss of the privilege, detention, and/or suspension.

**Eligibility for this privilege will be determined on a quarterly basis. Students can earn or lose these privileges during the course of the school year.** In order to be eligible, a student must have met the requirements during the fourth quarter of the previous year. Students eligible for Early Release/Late Arrival and Senior Open Campus must return a completed contract to the Main Office. This contract must be signed by both the student and his/her parent or guardian.

Students who secure a job and plan to use their Early Release/Late Arrival time for the job, should remember that the loss of the privilege will require them to stay at school and will jeopardize their employment.
