- ✚ The Weed Watcher Program is a volunteer-based monitoring activity for the early detection and reporting of invasive aquatic plants like milfoil.
- ✚ Turee Pond in Bow has been documented to support a fairly expansive growth of variable milfoil, and management efforts are underway.
- ✚ Local residents who visit and fish and boat on Turee Pond and other lakes and ponds are encouraged to monitor for any new or suspicious growths of plants or animals that could potentially be a concern, and report them to the NH Department of Environmental Services.
- ✚ Weed Watcher kits will be provided to volunteers who wish to become active monitors.
